

**Boone County Water Rescue  
Monthly Report  
May 2000**

**SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES**

- 1.) Team meetings.
- 2.) Other meetings: Supervisor, staff.
- 3.) Monthly meetings with Coast Guard
- 4.) Organizing an open house on a Saturday and Sunday with a target date in July
- 5.) Boats 218 and 219 are in service on the water at Villa Hills Marina
- 6.) Boat Patrol begins
- 7.) Fuel saving policies are put into effect due to price increases on the river
  - a. Maintaining lower rpm's during the normal duty hours only throttling up to clear engine buildup
  - b. Not throttling up the engines unless an emergency arises
  - c. Maintaining no more than 1500 rpm's using the center engine only shutting down the starboard and port engines
  - d. When the heat index rise's above 100 degrees anchor off or have crews on standby
  - e. In the event of adverse weather conditions have crew standby at the mooring area or anchor off and shut the engines down
  - f. When throttling up is necessary not to exceed no more than 4000 rpm's unless a emergency arises
  - g. If there is a low volume of boats the crew will be on standby at the mooring area or anchor off and shut the engines down

- 1.) Boone County House boat 10 people aboard 2:00am lost power, non-life threatening
- 2.) Kenton County, small pleasure craft Licking river 2 people aboard, non-life threatening

**Evidence Collection**

- 1.) Kenton County, City of Covington vehicle went in the water at the riverfront area vehicle removed (No occupants)
- 2.) Boone County various stolen or missing items recovered from a pond at Mosbey's Point trailer park
