

**BOONE COUNTY WATER RESCUE
MONTHLY REPORT
November 2002**

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

1. During the month of November is preparing all equipment dive gear, vehicles, and boats for cold water /weather operations. This includes removing 219 and 218 from the water and winterizing them and cleaning the boats inside and out. Any cold weather sensitive equipment is removed from the vehicles that are outside. Preparing dive equipment for cold water operations.
2. We will be checking all dive equipment in November and December that is needed for yearly maintenance.
3. All supervisors are reviewing their winter needs and replacement equipment.
4. An end of the year budget review is on going for all the different department heads.

TRAINING

1. Joint dive training took place at Camp Ernst Lake with Campbell County Water Rescue. The training including working on and around the twin-engine aircraft under the water this training helped the divers to understand the conditions and environment that they would be working in, the plane is in. Also training Campbell County on how to underwater camera equipment.
2. Ice Rescue training brochures have been sent out to all Public Safety departments, as of this date Hebron Fire Department will be sending 30 of there personnel to our Ice Rescue training course.
3. A target date to have a promotional video available on the internet describing the Ice Rescue Training and how any department can sign up for the training.

BOONE COUNTY

1. The Boone County Sheriff department requested us to check for a stolen car in the water at the Belleview Sand and Gravel Company. Under water camera's was used to search the area around the cofferdams, no vehicle was found.
