**GENERAL ACTIVITIES**

**Stolen Vehicle Recovery

1. **Requested to respond to the Licking River at Locust Pike Park/Landing. Found a stolen vehicle approximately 50 feet out from the Kenton County shoreline. The vehicle was removed and found to be stolen.**

**Kenton County**

1. **Received call on October 19<sup>th</sup> reference a sunken boat on the Licking River next to Banklick Creek, dispatched a boat to the scene and found a small boat just of the Covington shore line over half submerged, this boat has been there for sometime and would not impede navigational traffic. Attempted to run Ohio registration and found no record of the boat.**

### **Kenton County EMS support**

- 1. On October 19<sup>th</sup> we had three boats and 13 personnel involved in the Belle of Louisville and the Belle of Cincinnati boat race. EMS support was our primary function along with maintaining a secure area around the boats during the race and after. The agencies that participated were the Coast Guard and us. A complete walk thru boat boats was conducted to establish a boarding and off boarding of a patient if needed. There were no incidents reported during this detail.**
