

**BOONE COUNTY WATER RESCUE
MONTHLY REPORT
June 2003**

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

Various supervisor and general meetings were held concerning the budget, the biggest concern was if the team would be funded.

TRAINING

1. CPR & First aid training for ORSANCO
2. Diver Instructor recertification is on going, this is weekly and will continue until the first part of September.
3. June 7th and 8th diver recertification at Blue Springs Ohio completed
4. Personnel watercraft training was ongoing for June.

RESCUES

1. **Boone County:** a 21' boat lost power with 2 adults aboard upstream from the I-275 Bridge, the river was at 47' with a 3 mph current. The boat was anchored off approximately 1/4 mid stream from the left descending bank. The anchor had become lodged and could not be retrieved. The boat and occupants were towed to their campsite located at the end of Route 8.
2. **Campbell County:** we where working in Boone County near Petersburg when a distress call came in near Dayton Ky. reference a boating accident with people in the water. We contacted the Coast Guard and advised we were responding. A boater had witnessed the accident and helped get the people and the boat to the Dayton Dock. Dayton Police and Fire were at the scene helping the injured to the squads for transportation to the hospital. Dayton Police requested to come aboard our boat to help find the boat that left the scene of the accident. We checked the Licking River and various docks upstream and down.
3. **Kenton County:** A commercial boat (Lady Dean) contacted us reference a small pleasure craft adrift mid stream, we found the boat with 2 people aboard. The boat had lost power and was adrift. We towed the boat to the nearest dock.
