GENERAL ACTIVITIES

Details

Rescues\drowning\boating assist

1. Carroll County: Drowning in Kentucky River, 1 male recovered in about 20 feet of water. The subject was fishing and the boat capsized. The victim was found in an area full of trees and underbrush.
2. Campbell County: Drowning 4 male adults, a Barge 5 long and 3 wide ran over a houseboat only one subject survived. Requested to search the inside of the boat, our divers went inside the boat in about 27 feet of water in the middle of the river. The boat was thoroughly searched inside and around the boat. A second diver was requested to make the same search to make sure the entire boat was searched (all victims had been thrown out of the boat). The victims where found the following day by Campbell County Water Rescue and Dayton Fire, the victims resurfaced in the middle of the river .
3. Boone County: 30' cabin cruiser (engine failure) towed to safety.
4. Boone County: 17' fishing boat (engine failure) the boat was towed to a campground at Petersburg gravel pit. The two subjects was taken to Big Bone to get there trailer.
