

**BOONE COUNTY WATER RESCUE
MONTHLY REPORT
November 2005**

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

1. General team meetings, Fire chiefs meeting, ice rescue meeting and preparations. Ice rescue notifications have been sent to all Boone County Fire department on 11-26 all other department in Kenton and Campbell is scheduled to be sent out on December 5th.
2. Ice rescue training has been scheduled on January 7th, 14th, 28th and February 4th.
3. Ice Rescue equipment has been checked for any repair or maintenance.
4. Dive equipment is being checked for repair, general maintenance and replacement.
5. Weekly checks on boat 218 at Villa Hills Marina are on going. This boat will be ready to go if needed throughout the winter months.
6. Boat 219 has been removed from the water and will be stored at Villa Hills Marina thru the winter months.
7. Repair, cleaning, replacement supplies, repainting, lettering and general maintenance on boat 219 on going.
8. EMS supplies have been inventoried and replacement supplies ordered.
9. Underwater camera's maintenance and repair has been completed.
10. Side scan sonar training is scheduled December, 5th in Virginia 6 members will take the manufactured training course.

**Drowning
Grant Co. Bullock Pen Lake**

1. A male subject was towing a small boat when something entangled his trolling motor. The subject attempted to clear the prop and fell into the water and drowned. Grant County Water Rescue worked two days trying to locate the victim. On the third day Grant County Emergency Management requested our assistance. After arriving on the scene we found the victim in 17 feet of water approximately 15 to 20 feet out from shore. Approximate recovery time (less than 1 hour) Equipment used side scan sonar, drop cameras and divers. Also while looking for this subject we may have located a vehicle upside down in the same area as the victim. Further sonar work will be scheduled. Due to the area that the vehicle is in the vehicle will have to be raised and floated to the boat ramp. This detail will be scheduled in the coming weeks and would also include the following agencies; Grant County Sheriff's department, Grant County Water Rescue, Ky. Fish and Wild Life and Grant County Emergency.
