GENERAL ACTIVITIES

11. Visual searches for the victim that jumped off the I-75 are ongoing. Scheduling crews weekly ongoing.

Boone County

13. Evidence collection detail (vehicle) for Butler County Sheriff department in the Big Bone, Rabbit Hash, Gallatin County shore line. Found vehicle that was stolen out of Williamstown at the intersection of 127 and US 42 in 30 feet of water.

Russell County Lake Cumberland

14. 36-year-old Mark Sayers drowned after his boat collided with another boat June 30th in Wolf Creek, Local authorities requested our services July 13th on July 15th we found Mr. Sayers in over 50 feet of water.
